STEP 1: HOMEPAGE

- Go to this website: **www.oxfordlearn.com**




STEP 2: BEFORE REGISTRATION

- Click on **Register Here**.
- Your Oxford Learn student account might have already been created by your teacher/instructor for you. If this is the case, **DO NOT register again**.
- The language of the instructions can be changed to Turkish the right top of the page.



STEP 3: REGISTER AN ACCOUNT


- Enter your details.
- Your password must be **at least 6 characters**. It must contain; at least one lower-case letter, at least one upper-case letter and at least one number.



The registration form includes the following fields and instructions:


STEP 6: ACCESS CODE




